Fleet Captain's Report

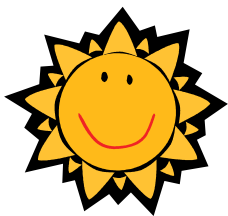

Summer has arrived and boating season is in full swing. May all of you be safe and have a wonderful time on the water.

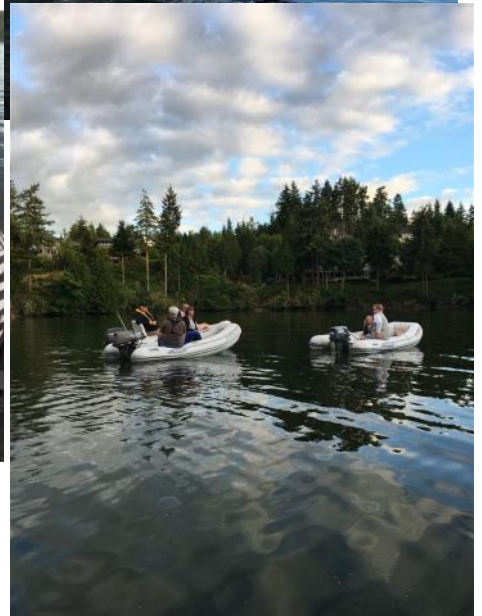
